#### FENTANYL THE INVISIBLE KILLER

Drugs may contain deadly level of fentany!. You cannot see, taste, or smell it. It is almost impossible to tell if a drug is laced with fentanyl unless tested with a fentany testing strip.

Fentanyl is a synthetic opioid that is **50-100 times more potent than morphine, often lethal with as little as 2 milligrams**.



This small amount is a LETHAL dose of fentanyl

- Call 911 immediately. Administer Naloxone or Narcan, if available.

- 5 Stay with them until emergency workers arrive.
